Project Summary: The Alaska Buildings site is a former Seal factory and was redeveloped to provide a mix of residential and commercial accommodation in 1992.

The iconic 600 Building Designed by architect Wallis Gilbert and constructed in the 1930s being a later addition to the site is a fine example of Art Deco design.

We have been retained since 2007 to provide surveying support dealing with the assessment and remediation of building defects and the commissioning and overseeing of major works programmes .

We are currently in the process of organizing the undertaking of a specialist concrete inspection of the 600 building structure as part of a feasibility analysis for external facade repairs and redecoration.

In conjunction with the above we continue to provide day to day reactive surveying support in respect of building defects which may arise and we act as freeholders Surveyor where licenses for alteration are required in respect on individual leaseholder adaptations.
